

ROSEVILLE DOG AREAS

The City of Roseville has four off leash fenced areas that offer recreation for your dog. All have some shade, benches, chairs, and turf.

Marco Dog Park -

The City of Roseville's first Dog Park. This park was named after Marco, a police dog killed in the line of duty. Marco Dog Park is located at 1800 Sierra Gardens Dr., just north of Douglas Blvd. Marco is the biggest of all the dog parks and has natural grassland areas, water, and wading pool areas. Marco Dog Park is closed during the winter months, because the park is a flood retention basin.

Bear Dog Park -

This park was named after Bear "Baron Von Der Kristin" who was the Roseville Police Dept.'s first K-9. Bear Dog Park is located at 1575 Pleasant Grove Blvd., within Mahany Park. This park has separate large and small dog areas with water, doggy showers, wading pool areas, a walking trail, obstacle equipment, and is open year round.

Hughes Dog Park -

This dog park is located at 1600 Parkside Way within William "Bill" Hughes Park (south side). This park has separate large and small dog areas, an off leash training area, water, and is open year round.

Saugstad Dog Run -

This dog run is located within Saugstad Park at 100 Buljan Dr. in Roseville. This dog run is more intended for exercising your dog, rather than socializing, and is open year round.



RDOG provides amenities (balls, water bowls, wading pools, etc.) as needed and works with the City of Roseville on maintenance issues, and improvements at the off leash areas.

RDOG REMINDS YOU. . .

- Take your dog to the Veterinarian at least yearly
- Give your dog regular dental care for healthy teeth
- Ask your Veterinarian about recommended vaccines
- It is important to spay or neuter your dog
- Take a Pet First Aid class
- Keep your dog fit and healthy with regular exercise
- Take your dog to training class
- Maintain your dog's good manners with consistent practice
- Keep your dog safe around children
- Make sure your dog travels safely and securely
- Always pick up after your dog
- Pass The AKC's Canine Good Citizen Test
- Follow leash laws

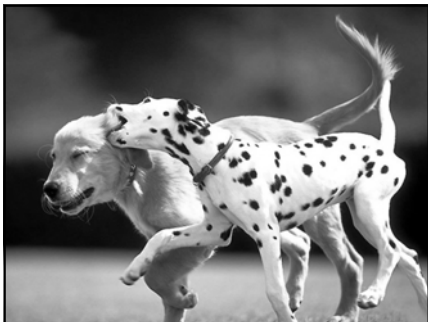
What is RDOG?

The Roseville Dog Owners' Group (RDOG) is a non-profit organization founded in 1996 for the purpose of promoting recreational opportunities for Roseville (Ca.) area dog owners and their companion animals. RDOG was instrumental in establishing Marco Dog Park, the city's first off-leash dog park, as well as Bear Dog Park and Hughes Dog Park. In 2009, Saugstad Dog Run opened.

Today, RDOG is a dog advocacy group, working closely with the City of Roseville to help maintain existing dog parks, and open new dogs parks where dogs and their owners can play and enjoy fun experiences.

We also offer recreational and educational activities in Roseville, and fun outings outside of the area. Our website and newsletter offer informative information on local dog events, training and health tips, organizational news, and most anything else that might be of interest to local dog owners. Most of all, we promote responsible dog ownership!

RDOG meets the second Thursday of each month at 7 pm, to discuss upcoming activities and events, handle the business of the organization, and enjoy a fun short educational program.
