Roseville Dog Owners' Group

RDOG is able to pursue the goal of promoting responsible dog ownership, help develop new dog parks, community education, and other activities because of the work of active volunteers and our fund raising efforts. Please look over the volunteer opportunities and find a committee (or two!) you would like to work on. We are always looking for new ideas!

Dog Park Task Force Committee

This committee focuses on partnering with the City of Roseville Parks Department with ongoing discussions regarding the opening and design of new dog parks. This is a highly important and visible committee for RDOG because of its direct impact on the community and dog parks.

Park Liaison Committees

These committees focus on partnering with the City of Roseville Parks Department to make improvements at all Roseville Dog Parks, and resolve maintenance issues. Each of the dog parks in Roseville has their own liaison committee:

- Bear Dog Park
- Dog Park within William Hughes Park
- Marco Dog Park

If you frequent one of the above parks, and would like a voice in how it is run and maintained, one of these committees are for you!

Education

This committee focuses on responsible dog ownership through education. This committee coordinates the Canine Good Citizen Program, Mutley Manners Dog Park Etiquette Seminars, and the *Fido is Part of the Family* Activity Books. It also coordinates educational workshops, and procures speakers with interesting information and experiences to share with the group at our monthly meetings. This is a fun committee to promote education, join now!

Fundraising

The Fundraising Committee coordinates and executes fund raising activities to generate funds for RDOG, the Placer SPCA Kennel sponsorship, and our parks fund. Last years fundraising events helped finance the waste bags used at the Marco Dog Park. This is an important committee to provide funds for the groups activities.

Activities Committee

The Activities Committee organizes group outings to places like the beach, the mountains, and other events. This committee also coordinates overnight events such as camping. This is a fun committee to identify new and interesting places to take our dogs on group outings. Come join this committee as we search for places off-leash.

Legislation Committee

This committee's mission is to provide dog owners in our community, a unified voice. This committee continues to work with the City to support new dog related legislation in Roseville, and changing existing laws, making Roseville a more dog friendly city. This is another highly visible committee, which will interact with the public, the Parks Commission and the City Council.

Membership Committee

The Membership Committee has the mission to increase membership in RDOG, both with individuals and businesses. By increasing membership, the group has more resources to finance park improvements and work towards making our community a more dog friendly place. This committee also is responsible for the renewal of it's members.
