Parks Committee

This committee focuses on partnering with the City of Roseville Parks Department to make improvements to Marco Dog Park. Achievements last year to the park included trash cans, additional benches, gravel replenishment, and lots of new trees. Also the storm drains were repaired and the water drainage cleared. Not to mention the concrete pool pad. This season should bring improvements to the pool pad, additional gravel, bulletin board replacement, another bench and a tree or two.

Ongoing discussions include the new dog park in West Roseville. This is a highly important and visible committee for RDOG because of its direct impact on the community and the dog park. If you are a frequent park user and would like a voice in how it is run and maintained, this is the committee for you!

Education and Publicity Committee

The E&P Committee focuses on responsible dog ownership through education and Publicity of RDOG. This committee coordinates the Canine Good Citizen Clinic and Tests which we plan to sponsor twice a year. This committee also hopes to work on an exciting project to produce a series of public service videos on selecting a dog, the different breeds of dogs, and more, which will be shown on Roseville Public Access television. This is another highly visible committee, which will interact with the public, the Parks Commission and the City Council. The video project in particular will be a lot of fun, so join now!

Fundraising Committee

The Fundraising Committee coordinates and executes our highly-successful bake sales to generate funds for RDOG and our parks fund. Last years fundraising events helped finance

the 52,000 waste bags used at the park! This is an important committee to provide funds for the group's activities.

Activities Committee

The Activities Committee organizes group outings to places like the beach, the mountains, and other events, especially during the rainy season when the dog park is closed. This committee also procures speakers with interesting information and experiences to share with the group at our monthly meetings. Past speakers have included animal control officers, veterinarians, and assistance dog trainers for the disabled. This is a fun committee to identify new and interesting topics for the group meetings.

Legislation Committee

This committee is a committee with the mission to provide dog owners in our community with a unified voice. The committee is in the process of defining legislative goals, including securing funding for a proposed dog park in West Roseville and relaxing the on-leash dog ban in city parks. The legislation committee was successful in helping to draft the newest City of Roseville leash ordinance.

Membership Committee

The Membership Committee has the mission to increase membership in RDOG, both with individuals and business sponsorships. By increasing membership, the group has more resources to finance park improvements and work towards making our community a more dog friendly place. This year the committee will focus on gaining support through increased business memberships along with getting increased membership exposure from local dog related businesses.
